Temple Beth El Cantor's Message

On January 31st, you may have noticed a bit of hullabaloo regarding what was being called a super blue blood moon. This referred to the fact that the new moon on the 31st was a blue moon, being the second new moon in the calendar month, a "super" moon because it occurred when the moon was at its nearest approach to the Earth and thus appeared roughly 14% larger in the sky and a "blood" moon because it coincided with a total lunar eclipse when the moon, sitting in the Earth's shadow, takes on a reddish hue. The confluence of these factors results in such a new moon being fairly rare.

We are going to see yet another calendrical rarity this year: both Purim and Passover will occur in the same (secular) calendar month. We read the megillah on Wednesday night, February 28th, but Purim is the next day, March 1st. We will then celebrate the first seder on Friday night, March 30th, meaning that the first day of Passover is Shabbat, March 31st.

Just how rare is it for Purim and Passover to both occur in March? For most of us alive today, this will be the first time in our lifetimes that such a thing happens. It happened only three times in the 20th century (1904, 1934 and 1953) and only twice in the 18th century. The next occurrence will be in 2029. All in all, fairly rare.

There are other infrequent occurrences in the Jewish Calendar. Every 50th year, we are told by the Torah to celebrate the jubilee year. In fact, the Jubilee has not been celebrated in over 2,600 years, the last time all of the tribes of Israel lived on their ancestral lands by tribe. There is also the birkat HaChamah, said every 28 years when the sun is the same position in the sky as when it was placed there by God on the 4th day of creation. Our next opportunity to say that blessing will be in 2037 (too bad if you missed it in 2009).

Why all of the fuss about the calendar? In Exodus 12, God says to Moses and Aaron: "This month (Nissan, the month of Passover) will be for you the head of months; it will be the first month of the year." Inherent in that statement is the command to count months. And so we count, not just months, but years, weeks, days and even hours. The Hebrew Calendar is an ingenious solution to the dilemma of bringing the lunar year and the solar year into consonance. It gives us the framework upon which to build our lives. As the Psalmist wrote, "Teach us to number our days, that we may get a heart of wisdom." (Ps. 90:12)

As we celebrate Purim and Passover this month, and note the beginning of the month of Nissan, let us take a moment to consider the calendar. Let's think about how it provides a guide, and also platform. Let us all endeavor to number our days so that we may get hearts of wisdom.

Helen and Leon Sperling Holocaust Memorial Lecture and Yom Hashoah Observance

Please set aside Tuesday, April 10th for the Helen and Leon Sperling Holocaust Memorial Observance and Speaker. The annual program will be held at The Jewish Community Center at 7:30 PM. Our guest speaker this year will be Frank Grunwald, a child survivor of the Holocaust.

Frank Grunwald was 6-years-old when German troops invaded Czechoslovakia in March 1939. In the summer of 1942, he and his family were deported to the Terezin ghetto and in December 1943 to Auschwitz. He survived three other concentration camps and a death march before U.S. soldiers liberated him in May 1945. He's had a fulfilling career, supplemented by his love of music and skill as a sculptor. Today Frank lives in Indianapolis with his wife and family.

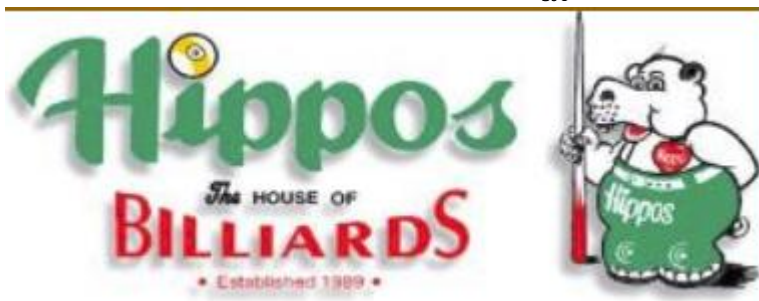

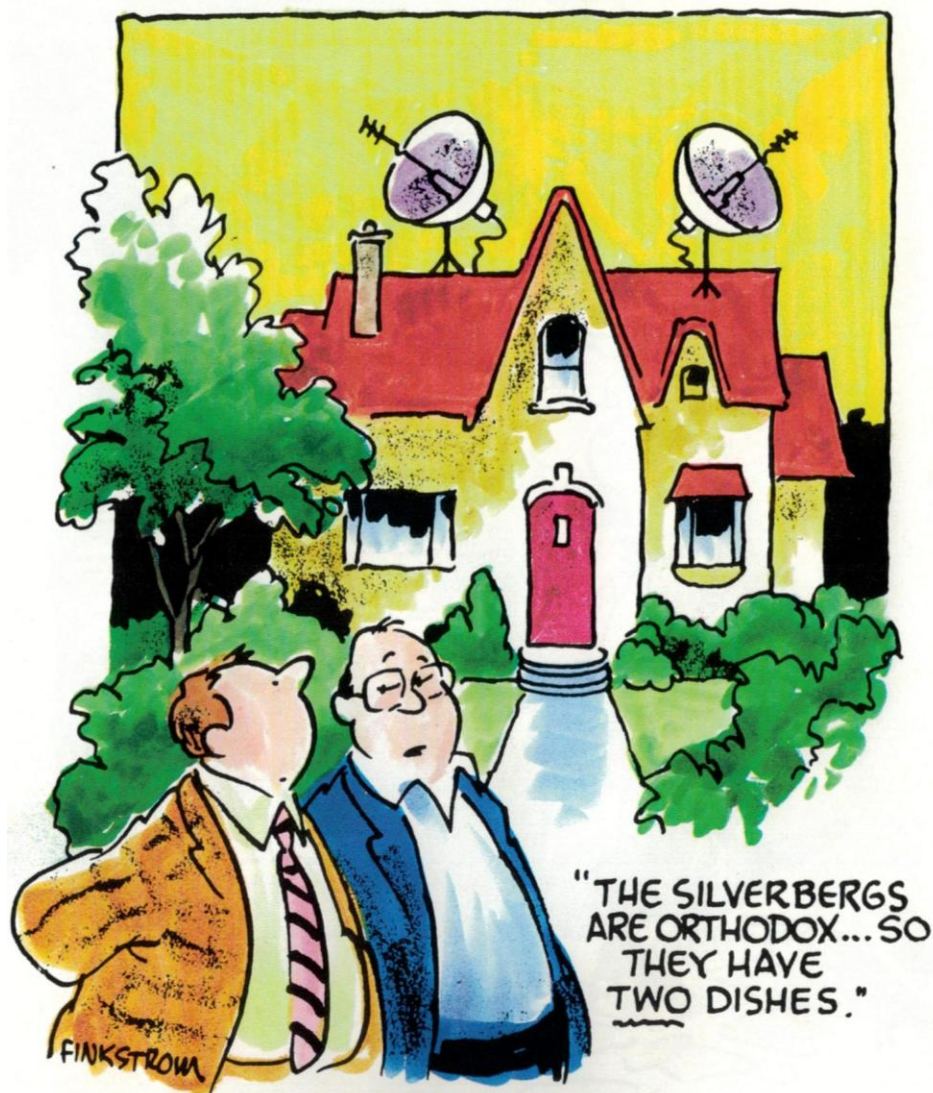
